

2008 PA Junior Dairy Show Leasing Rule

Leased animals may be exhibited at the Pennsylvania Junior Dairy Show. Existence of a lease must be verified by the home county or school; the county or school must have the lease and/or project plan (or knowledge of the lease) recorded by **June 1, 2008**. Leased animals must be housed in Pennsylvania unless approval is received from PA Junior Dairy Show director. Cows may only be leased by the exhibitor only if they were previously leased as calves or yearlings. Parents and guardians and siblings are not permitted to lease animals to their children or siblings; likewise, an exhibitor who owns animals may not lease other project animals. At the time of check-in, exhibitors of leased animals must present a copy of a signed lease, signed project plan, or verification letter from an extension agent or teacher that the animal is a properly leased animal.
