Youth Safety

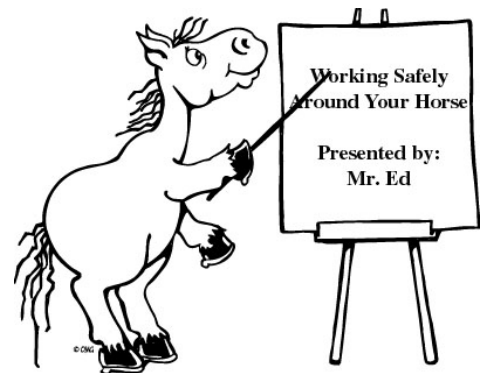
Horse Handling Safety
