

4-H Dairy and Livestock Breeding Animal Leasing Program Project Plan

Instructions

1. Write a separate plan for each animal you lease. Have your leader, parent, and animal's owner approve it.
2. A written lease is not required. If your parents or the animal's owner want a written lease, you must send it to the county extension office for approval by the 4-H insurer before you sign it. Allow at least a month for the insurer to approve it.
3. Send a copy of the plan and the signed lease (if there is a written lease) to the county extension office by May 1.
4. Review the project agreement with your leader and the animal's owner before each show to verify that you are doing the project tasks you agreed to do.
5. Send a copy of the agreement with the signatures of your leader and animal's owner to the county extension office before the end deadline for each show.
