**Breeding Contract Information:**

1. Select either “Bred on the Farm” or “Shipped Cooled Semen”.
2. Complete all information on the breeding contract, sign, and return it to The Pennsylvania State University Horse Barn c/o Ed Jedrzejewski, DVM, or Chris Grant.
  - A. If you are breeding via Shipped Cooled Semen, complete and return Form A, Terms and Conditions for Shipped Cooled Semen
  - B. If you are sending your mare to the farm you will need to complete and return Form B, Mare Information/Disclosure Statement~Breeding at Farm
3. Enclose Non-refundable Booking Fee (\$200.00) with contracts.
4. Enclose copy of mare’s papers (front and back).

Once The Pennsylvania State University has accepted and executed the Breeding Contract, a copy will be returned to you.

**Mares Bred at The Pennsylvania State University~prior to or at the time of their arrival, the following paperwork must have been received by The Pennsylvania State University:**

1. Completed Breeding Contract and Form B
2. Copy of a negative Coggins test *within the current calendar year*.
3. Copy of reproductive exam performed by your veterinarian.
4. Copy of veterinary health certificate dated within 2 weeks.
5. Copy of current deworming and immunization record. Mares without proper vaccinations will be updated upon arrival.

At the time the mare is released from The Pennsylvania State University premises, all fees and expenses must be paid in full. Credit cards **are not** accepted.

**Before the Mare Owner is shipped cooled semen:**

1. Completed Breeding Contract and Form A must be on file.
2. Breeding fee must be paid in full.
3. All fees from any previous semen shipments must be paid in full.

Please ask about the availability of shipped cooled semen. Mares being bred via shipped semen will be given preference when booking to certain stallions due to the limited stall space we have available. Breeding fee is to be paid in full prior to first shipment of semen or before the mare leaves The Pennsylvania State University.

#### ***Shipped Semen Fees:***

First collection/shipment via Standard Fed-Ex/UPS over night delivery is included in the Breeding Fee. Note: This does not apply to Rebreds, Futurity breedings, Stallion Auction service breedings or Donated breedings. If Counter to Counter Shipment is required: additional charge is \$\_\_\_\_\_. Counter to Counter shipment fee will be determined by where you live and what method of delivery is needed. Depending on the situation we may not be able to offer this service to everyone.

For subsequent shipments via Standard Fed-Ex/UPS over night delivery the collection/shipment charge is \$175.00 (\$140 if customer pickup at farm). \$\_\_\_\_\_ Additional Charge via Counter to Counter Air Shipment (Total \$\_\_\_\_\_)

Mare owners may forward their own shipping container (**BOLDLY** marked with your name and address on all the parts). We ship using both reusable Equitainers and disposable cardboard shipping containers. You may state a preference. Please mark what type of shipping container you would prefer or if you don't have a preference just mark none (\_\_\_\_\_). We will do our best but, due to limited availability we may not be able to honor your request. Equitainers must be returned to the Farm, prepaid at Mare Owners expense within 3 working days from original shipment or a \$25/Day Rental Charge will be assessed. Equitainers not returned within 2 weeks will be billed to the mare owner at the price of \$300. Cardboard shipping containers cost \$\_\_\_\_\_. Any applicable shipped semen charges will be billed at the end of the current breeding (heat) cycle and must be paid in full prior to any requests for semen shipments in a subsequent breeding (heat cycle). In addition, we reserve the right to withhold the issuance of a Stallion Service or Breeder's Certificate until the mare owner is current on all payment obligations to The Pennsylvania State University.

## **2009 Breeding Fees**

### **The Pennsylvania State University Horse Barn**

#### ***Mare Care Fees for Mares Bred at the Farm:***

\$ 12 per day- Dry

\$ 14 per day- Wet

\$ 175 Chute Fee for all mares bred on the farm. This includes routine palpations, inseminations (for mares being bred artificially), and HCG if necessary. All other veterinary reproductive procedures deemed necessary will be charged separately. The initial chute fee covers the first two heat cycles for that mare if necessary. An additional chute fee of \$100 will be charged for each additional heat cycle for which the mare is at the farm during the current year. If rebreeding is necessary, new chute fees will be assessed in the following year as per the new breeding contract.

The chute fee, accrued board, veterinary expenses, mare care, farrier expenses, and other related charges shall become due and payable prior to or at the time mare is picked up. In addition, we reserve the right to withhold the issuance of a Stallion Service or Breeder's Certificate until the mare owner is current on all payment obligations to The Pennsylvania State University.

## Penn State University Horse Farm 2009 Breeding Contract

This contract is entered into and is between The Pennsylvania State University, referred to as "Farm" or "Stallion Owner" and Mare Owner who is the owner or lessee of mare described below. This contract sets forth the rights and responsibilities of the parties for the 2009 breeding season. To complete the agreement, the mare owner must also complete either Form A, "Shipped Cooled Semen", or for mares to be bred at the farm Form B, "Mare Information/ Disclosure". The form(s) needed will be noted on Page 3 in the section "Additional Terms and Conditions." The stallion providing breeding services under this contract is \_\_\_\_\_ (stallion). Mare Owner is the owner or lessee of a certain registered mare having the registered name of \_\_\_\_\_, Registration # \_\_\_\_\_, breed \_\_\_\_\_. It is now agreed between the parties as follows:

**Booking and Stallion Fee:** Mare Owner agrees to pay a non-refundable booking fee of \$200 to reserve a breeding for the year 2009, which shall be part of the Stallion Service Fee. The farm hereby agrees to breed the stallion, \_\_\_\_\_, to the mare belonging to Mare Owner as described above for the total breeding fee of \$ \_\_\_\_\_. Breeding fee paid is only for the above mentioned mare. Multiple pregnancies are prohibited. In the event that an additional mare is inseminated and a foal results; an additional full stallion service fee will be due and payable to the Farm.

Any applicable shipped semen charges will be billed at the end of the current breeding (heat) cycle and must be paid in full prior to any requests for semen shipments in a subsequent breeding (heat cycles), these fees include but are not limited to counter-to-counter fees, overnight shipping fees, or Equitainer late fees. Mare owners may forward their own shipping container (BOLDLY marked with your name and address on all the parts). We ship using both reusable Equitainers and disposable cardboard shipping containers. You may state a preference. Please mark what type of shipping container you would prefer or if you don't have a preference just mark none (\_\_\_\_\_). We will do our best but, due to limited availability we may not be able to honor your request. Equitainers must be returned to the Farm, prepaid at Mare Owners expense within 3 working days from original shipment or a \$25/Day Rental Charge will be assessed. Equitainers not returned within 2 weeks will be billed to the mare owner at the price of \$300. Cardboard shipping containers cost \$ \_\_\_\_\_.

Completed Form B, "Mare Disclosure/Information" required ~ Expected Arrival Date: \_\_\_\_\_. balance of the breeding fee \$ \_\_\_\_\_ as set forth above will be due prior to or at time of pick up of the mare from The Pennsylvania State University. \$ 175 Chute Fee for all mares bred on the farm. This includes routine palpations, inseminations (for mares being bred artificially), and HCG if necessary. All other veterinary reproductive procedures deemed necessary will be charged separately. The initial chute fee covers the first two heat cycles for that mare if necessary. An additional chute fee of \$100 will be charged for each additional heat cycle for which the mare is at the farm during the current year. If rebreeding is necessary, new chute fees will be assessed in the following year as per the new breeding contract. The chute fee, accrued board, veterinary expenses, mare care, farrier expenses, and other related charges shall become due and payable prior to or at time of pick up of the mare. The mare owner agrees

to pay all charges when due and should the mare owner fail to do so, the farm is entitled to recover any costs, interest, expenses and attorney's fees expended in collection.

**Shipped Cooled Semen:** Collection/Shipping days are Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Saturday. Semen must be ordered by **5 PM EST** the day prior to Collection/Shipping date. The farm agrees that the mare owner may pick up at the farm, or the farm will send the first shipment of semen via Fed-Ex or similar next day delivery free of charge to Mare Owner. If shipment is sent via same day air, the mare owner agrees to pay \$\_\_\_\_\_ extra shipping charge prior to shipment of semen. This fee will be determined by where you live and what method we need to use. Depending on the situation we may not be able to offer this service to everyone. If subsequent shipments of semen are required during this cycle or future cycles, the mare owner agrees to pay all applicable fees as set forth in Form A, "Shipped Cooled Semen Agreement". The mare owner further agrees to satisfy any late fees associated with use of an Equitainer.

**Mare Care and Board:** The mare owner hereby states that he/she has inspected the premises of the breeding farm, including the facilities in which the mare is to be kept and is satisfied with their condition, upkeep, and safety. The mare owner agrees that the standard of care to be imposed upon the farm is that of ordinary care of a prudent horse owner. The mare owner agrees to provide the farm with a reasonable and sufficient opportunity to settle the mare; at least two heat periods. The mare owner assumes all responsibility for pregnancy testing. The mare owner agrees to have their mare pregnancy checked within forty-five days from the date of last breeding and notify the farm of the results within five days from the date of the pregnancy check.

**Mare Owner Warrants:** The mare owner agrees to submit completed Form B, "Mare Disclosure/Information" either prior to or upon arrival of the mare on the premises of the breeding facility. Mare/Mare and foal is, to the mare owner's knowledge, free from transmittable illnesses or diseases. The mare shall be halter broke and reasonably safe for handling and breeding. Rear shoes shall be removed. All mares shall be accompanied upon arrival by a negative COGGINS TEST dated within the current calendar year and a veterinary health certificate dated within two weeks indicating a current vaccination for RHINOPNEUMONITIS, INFLUENZA, TETANUS TOXOID, RABIES, STRANGLES and EASTERN/WESTERN Encephalomyelitis. The mare owner will also present the results of a reproductive exam performed by their veterinarian. Procedures performed will be at the discretion of the mare owner's veterinarian. Mares not accompanied by a certificate will be vaccinated shortly after arrival at the farm at the expense of the mare owner. The mare owner authorizes the farm, to perform any routine reproductive veterinary services, (such as but not limited to palpation) as the farm veterinarians may deem reasonably necessary. Depending on the stallion that the mare is booked to and at the Farms discretion, the mare may be bred either naturally or via artificial insemination. If unable to be contacted in a timely manner, the mare owner authorizes the farm veterinarians to perform any reasonably necessary emergency veterinary procedures needed for the proper treatment, care and protection of the mare and/or foal at her side until the owner can be contacted. All veterinary procedures are to be done at the mare owner's expense and will be billed and payable as described above.

**Live Foal Guarantee:** This contract is a "Live Foal" contract. "Live Foal" is herein defined as a newborn foal, which stands and nurses without assistance and lives for twenty-four (24) hours. Should this mating not produce a live foal, it must be evidenced by a written statement from a licensed veterinarian dated within one month from the date of death of the fetus/foal, or in the alternative, a sworn statement from a veterinarian that the mare is no longer in foal and the date of the fetus loss is unknown. When applicable, proof that the mare had been given Rhinopneumonitis vaccinations during her fifth, seventh, and ninth months of gestation must also be provided. If the foal is born dead, or if the mare does not otherwise carry to term, there shall be a return privilege in the current season 2009 or the following breeding season 2010. The stallion owner must be notified within six (6) months of the mare's due date if a live foal does not result from the breeding covered by this contract. Arrangements to rebreed the mare during the year that the mare was expected to foal or to use the breeding in a future breeding season must be made within six (6) months of the mare's due date or the "Live Foal" guarantee will become null and void. Third year rebreeds are subject to an additional booking fee plus any increases in the breeding fee. There is no live foal guarantee on third year rebreeds. Substitution of a different mare will be allowed for second or third year rebreeds.

In the event of the death, debilitating injury, or sale of the above-named stallion, this contract shall become null and void. The breeding fee will be refunded to the mare owner if the mare has not been bred. In the event of the stallion's death, debilitating injury, or sale prior to the delivery of a live foal, the Live Foal guarantee as described above shall become null and void. If the mare is bred, but does not produce a live foal in the subsequent year; evidenced by a sworn statement from a licensed veterinarian, the mare owner may chose to breed to one of the other university stallions, or receive a refund of the breeding fee less the non-refundable booking fee. Should the mare die or become unfit to breed prior to breeding, the mare owner shall be required to breed a substitute mare to the stallion, or, a transfer of the breeding may be allowed at the sole discretion of the farm. NO refunds shall be permitted. NO other fees or charges are refundable except as described in this paragraph. NO fees related to board or breeding the mare are refundable.

**General Conditions:** It is understood that the breeding season for the farm commences on February 1 of the calendar year and terminates July 1 of the same calendar year. Mares that do not come into season or are not settled within this breeding season as described above shall be carried over to the following year. There are no free shipments in the rebreed year.

**Liability:** The Farm shall not be liable for any sickness, disease, theft, death, or injury which may be suffered by the mare and/or foal at side, or any other problem whatsoever arising out of or connected in any way with the breeding or boarding of the mare and/or foal unless the Farm directly caused the injury due to gross negligence or willful and wanton misconduct on their part in breeding, handling, and/or keeping of the mare. The mare owner is responsible for designating a fair value for the mare to be bred on "Form B" Mare Information/Disclosure Statement. The mare owner fully understands that the Farm does not carry any public liability, accidental injury, theft or equine mortality insurance on any outside horses in its possession, custody or control for breeding and boarding and that all risks connected with the breeding and boarding of the mare and/or mare and foal are to be borne by the mare owner.

In the event of colic or life threatening illness of the mare and/or foal all possible means available will be used to contact the mare and/or foal's owner to discuss treatment options; however, if the Farm is unable to contact the mare and/or foal's owner all means available will be utilized to save the mare/foal unless otherwise specifically instructed by the mare owner, including referral for surgery or other treatment not available at the Farm, if recommended by the farm veterinarian. The mare owner will pay any and all costs associated with the treatments or other expenses. The mare owner must waive/exclude specific veterinary care in writing on Form B, "Mare Information/Disclosure Statement addendum" to this breeding contract.

Mare Owner agrees to hold Stallion Owner/Farm harmless if Mare does not settle.

**Governing Law and Legal Venue:** This contract shall be governed by the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Any and all legal actions arising out of this contract shall take place in the local courts of the County of Centre, Pennsylvania.

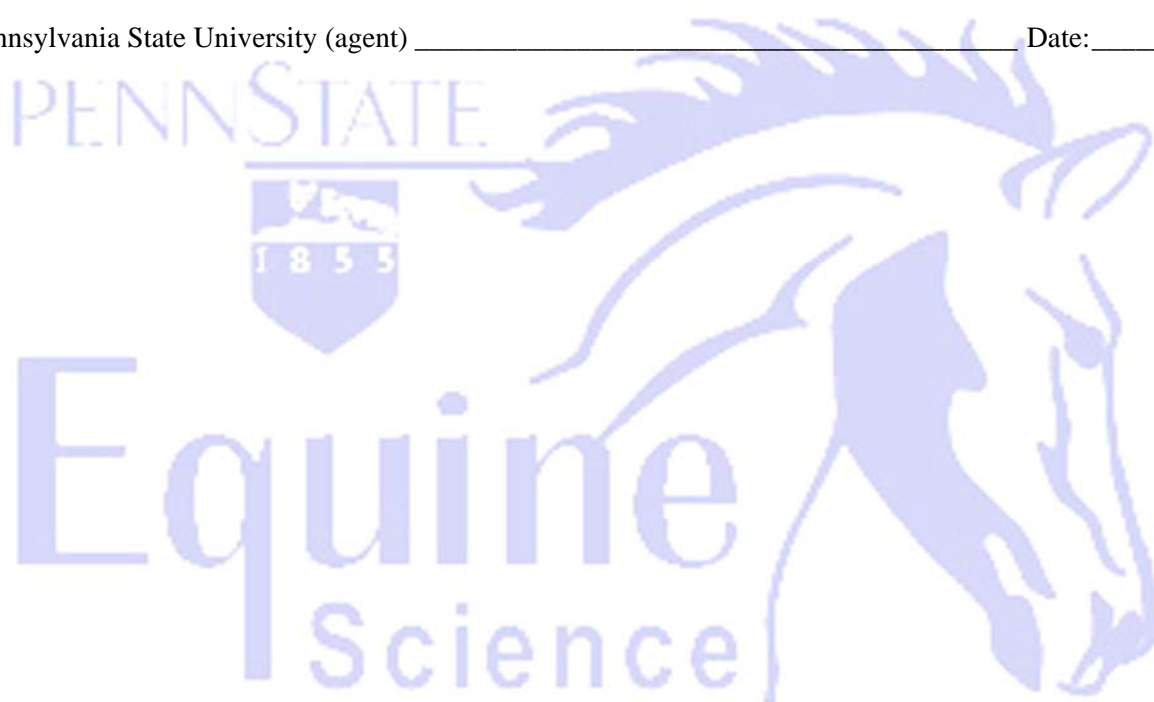

## **Form A ~ Terms & Conditions for Shipped Cooled Semen Penn State University Horse Barn**

This agreement, Form A is part of the 2009 Breeding Contract, and is entered into on the date recorded below by The Pennsylvania State University, known as "Stallion Owner" and hereinafter referred to as "Stallion Owner" or "Farm" and the "Mare Owner/Lessor" whose name or signature appears below and hereinafter referred to as "Mare Owner".

Farm shall ship semen collected from stallion in an appropriate chilled semen container by an overnight courier, such as Federal Express, Airborne, UPS, etc. to the address of record provided in writing by the Mare Owner on the day when the semen is collected. If semen is needed the same day, it will be sent via airline, if available, and the Mare Owner will be responsible for all additional fees incurred in counter to counter (CTC) shipment of the semen. Stallion Owner/Farm further certifies that the semen, when collected, will be of such a degree of motility to be acceptable for breeding.

The Mare Owner certifies that the Farm is obligated to transport cooled semen to the address of record, which has been provided in writing (below) by the Mare Owner prior to any shipment. If the Mare Owner requests more than one shipment, the semen will be shipped to the last known address of record provided by the Mare Owner to the Farm unless otherwise specified in writing and confirmed by the Farm.

All parties agree that prior to first shipment of semen all breeding fees must be paid in full. It is further agreed that the initial Fed-Ex or similar next day semen shipment to the Mare Owner is part of the breeding fee. If same day air service is required, Mare Owner agrees to pay \$\_\_\_\_\_. This will be determined by where you live and what method is needed to be used. Depending on the situation we may not be able to offer this service to everyone. For subsequent shipments via Standard Fed-Ex/UPS over night delivery the collection/shipment charge is \$175.00 (\$140 if customer pickup at farm). \$\_\_\_\_\_ Additional Charge via Counter to Counter Air Shipment (Total \$\_\_\_\_\_)

Mare owners may forward their own shipping container (BOLDLY marked with your name and address on all the parts). We ship using both reusable Equitainers and disposable cardboard shipping containers. You may state a preference. Please mark what type of shipping container you would prefer or if you don't have a preference just mark none (\_\_\_\_\_). We will do our best but, due to limited availability, we may not be able to honor your request. Any applicable shipped semen charges will be billed at the end of the current breeding(heat) cycle and must be paid in full prior to any requests for semen shipments in a subsequent breeding(heat cycle).

The Mare Owner certifies that only the Mare who is the subject of the breeding contract shall be inseminated by the shipped cooled semen of \_\_\_\_\_ (stallion). NOTE: If semen is used on a Mare other than as stated in the contract, Mare Owner shall owe a second full stud fee to Stallion Owner.

Best efforts will be made to provide shipped cooled semen on an as required basis according to Farm's Collection/Shipment days. However, a contract for cooled semen does not guarantee that semen will be available on the day you submit your request. Cooled semen bookings will be, by necessity, of limited availability if the stallion's book fills.

**All requests for semen must be made by 5 PM EST the day prior to Collection/Shipping date.** Semen requests are filled in the order in which they are received. However, mare owners ordering semen for the first time in a particular cycle will be given preference over mare owners ordering a second or third shipment for a particular cycle. Shipped semen may only be requested to ship on regularly scheduled breeding days. **Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Saturday** are

Collection/Shipping/Breeding days. **Sorry. No Exceptions Are Available!** Mare Owner may be responsible for shipping charges for cancellations received after 9 AM EST on shipping days if semen has already been processed. We will make every attempt to get cooled semen to your mare in good condition; however, we make no guarantees or warranties that the semen will be in good condition upon arrival.

The Mare Owner agrees to comply with all AQHA, or other breed association requirements concerning the use and handling of Transported Cooled Semen. The Mare Owner shall properly send the appropriate copies of Collection/Insemination Certificate to their breed association and to the Stallion Owner. The parties further agree to strictly abide by Rule 209 as contained in the AQHA Official Handbook or as modified and amended from time to time by the AQHA.

Stallion Owner and Mare Owner to execute a "Transported Semen Breeders Certificate" shall comply with any parentage verification as required by the American Quarter Horse Association or other breed associations. Fees for parent verification are the Mare Owner's expense.

This agreement is limited to the breeding season of **2009**. ~

## **Shipped Semen Procedures Penn State University Horse Barn**

### **Remaining Paper Work Required:**

Please mail in any remaining paperwork, i.e. contract, registration papers, etc. as soon as possible to The Pennsylvania State University. This must be received at the address below ahead of your semen request. Also please provide a copy of this page to your veterinarian.

### **Payment of Stud Fee Balance and Shipped Semen Charges:**

- Any balance of stud fee is due before the first shipment of semen or fees from prior shipments of semen are due prior to the ordering of semen for another heat cycle. Checks should be made payable to The Pennsylvania State University and mailed to: The Pennsylvania State University Horse Barn, University Park, PA 16802

### **Please Contact Us Directly for Ordering Semen:**

Semen may be ordered by phone or E-mail. **You must order by 5 PM EST the day before the collection day.** Collection days are **Monday, Wednesday, Friday, and Saturday.** Monday, Wednesday, and Friday orders can be shipped overnight or counter to counter. **Saturday orders can only be sent counter to counter.** Orders will be processed in the order they are received. If you need to cancel an order it must be cancelled by 9 AM EST or the mare owner may be liable for shipping charges if we have already processed the order when you call in a cancellation.

1. Stallion for which you are ordering semen
2. Mare owners name
3. Name of mare(s) to be bred
4. Address/city to which the semen is to be sent
5. Date the semen is to arrive
6. Advise if Counter to Counter service is required
7. Please leave your name and a phone number where you may be reached in case of questions.

**Please**, if you are leaving a phone message speak slowly, clearly, and spell any words that may be difficult to retrieve from the machine so that we get the information correct. 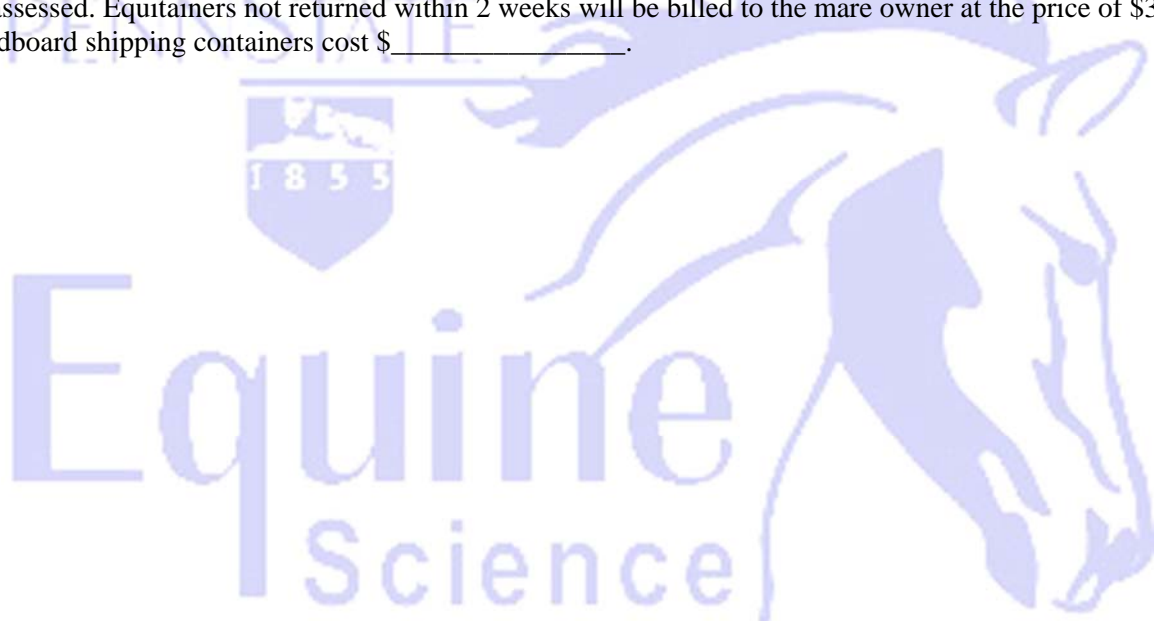
