

PA State 4-H Horse Show - Production Division

Rules and Combined Class Policy

It is the responsibility of all exhibitors who qualify for the Pennsylvania State 4-H Horse Show to be aware of and abide by the rules in the current PA 4-H Horse Show Rule Book and any available supplement(s). These rules will be in effect for the 2008 PA State 4-H Horse Show.

All production division exhibitors in the State Show should review Production Project Guidelines, Production Rules, pages 11 – 16 and General Rules, pages 1-11 of the current rule book and any appropriate supplement.

Please be aware of the following policy regarding combined classes at the State Show:

If there are less than two horses entered in a State Show class, the classes may be combined and the entries shown together. If there is no reasonable combination of entries, single entries will be shown individually in separate classes. Those exhibitors showing in a combined or single entry class exhibitors will be notified by September 20 or as soon as possible. **Single entry classes will not be canceled.**

PLEASE NOTE:

State show entry fees will not be refunded for classes combined due to lack of entries, since those exhibitors may participate in the combined class. Exhibitors should consider this policy when making state show entries.

There is no accurate method to determine the total number of entries in each state class until after all the entries have been entered in the computer program and classes combined in mid to late September.
